

- Except to allow for the removal of diseased vegetation and rotten or damaged trees, ALL vegetative cutting on a parcel with shoreline on a lake, pond, or navigable river or stream must comply with the following Adirondack Park restrictions:

- (a) Within 35 feet of the mean high-water mark, no more than 30 percent of the trees in excess of six inches diameter at breast height (4-1/2 feet above ground) may be cut over any 10-year period.
- (b) Within 6 feet of the mean high-water mark, no more than 30 percent of **any** vegetation may be
