## Shoreline Cutting Restrictions

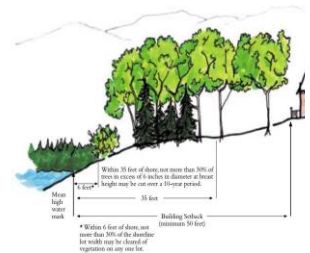

- Town Wide **Garage Sale** July 31 call the clerk to have your sale listed on the map by Wed 7/28.

Except to allow for the removal of diseased vegetation and rotten or damaged trees, ALL vegetative cutting on a parcel with shoreline on a lake, pond, or navigable river or stream must comply with the following Adirondack Park restrictions:

(a) Within 35 feet of the mean high-water mark, no more than 30 percent of the trees in excess of six inches diameter at breast height (4-1/2 feet above ground) may be cut over any 10-year period.

(b) Within 6 feet of the mean high-water mark, no more than 30 percent of **any** vegetation may be removed.



**NO BURNING** of on-site of Limbs & Branches March 16 to May 14 **ANYWHERE** in NY State  
Small Campfire are OK. No more than 3 ft. high 3 ft. wide.

### Safety Is Everyone' Responsibility

Look for the 'diver down' flag, red with a white diagonal stripe, as shown here when on the water.



Boaters and Personal Watercraft operators should **keep at least 100 feet away**. Outside of 100 feet, approach with caution and decrease speed. **Pass** these flags **as wide as possible**, and be on the lookout for air bubbles indicating the diver's position.
